Special Report - Pamplona's new 5-star boutique hotel

Iberian Traveler, along with our partners in Pamplona, Incoming Navarra, have been invited to preview the newly renovated **Gran Hotel La Perla**, scheduled to reopen in May as a 5-star boutique hotel after being closed for two years. It will be the only 5-star hotel in Pamplona. The hotel will offer six different room types, three with balconies overlooking Calle Estafeta and the route of the bulls, and three overlooking the Plaza del Castillo, the central square in the Old City.

The hotel will offer enhanced security. Rooms are for the exclusive use of registered guests only, but friends can be invited with the prior consent of the General Manager.

The hotel will feature a restaurant serving traditional Navarran cuisine that will be open to the public; advance reservations are required during the fiesta, including for registered guests.

Please note that the renovated hotel is small and has a limited number of rooms, some of which have already been pre-booked. There is a 4-night minimum stay required between 5 and 9 July. The standard two-night minimum package is available from 10 through 14 July.

Gran Hotel La Perla reservations for Sanfermín 2007

Room types:

Abuhardilladas – Penthouse or Dormer Room overlooking C/Estafeta - no balcony.

Vistas Al Encierro – Standard rooms with a balcony on C/Estafeta.

Personajes de La Perla – Deluxe rooms named for the hotel's famous guests; the bullfighters Manolete and Belmonte, Orson Wells and the Navarran musician Juan Gayarre. These rooms all have a small sitting area. Some overlook C/Estafeta while the others overlook the Plaza del Castillo and have a balcony.

Habitaciones Especiales – Deluxe Suites paying tribute to the hotel's most legendary historic guests; Ernest Hemingway, Pablo Sarasate, Don Juan de Borbón and La Casa Real Española. Hemingway's room has a balcony overlooking C/Estafeta and retains some of the original furnishings.

Join us in Pamplona for the **chupinazo**, at noon on 6 July when the fiesta begins with the firing of the rockets announcing the start of the **Fiesta de San Fermín**.
